Brown Act, and the <u>Temporary Rules of Council</u> as approved on June 9, 2020.

During the current State of Emergency and in the interest of public health and safety, most—and possibly all—of the Housing Authority Members will be participating in Housing Authority meetings by teleconference. In accordance with the Executive Order, there will be no members of the public participating in person at the Housing Authority Meetings. Comments received by the start of the meeting will be distributed to the Housing Authority members and posted online with the meeting materials. All webform comments are limited to 200 words. Comments received after the start of the meeting but before the item is called will be submitted into the written record for the relevant item.

- 2) Affirm that the President & CEO, or designee, is authorized to commit \$5 million in matching funds on a dollar-for-dollar basis from the City of San Diego's (City) Affordable Housing Fund, as required by the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) and as previously approved in Resolution No. HA-1868; and
- 3) Affirm that the President & CEO, or designee, is authorized to execute all documents and instruments that are necessary and/or appropriate to implement these approvals, in a form

approved by General Counsel, and to take such actions as are necessary and/or appropriate to implement these approvals, as previously approved in Resolution No. HA-1868.
