Approval of the minutes of the July 9, 2008 and July 18, 2008 special meetings.

ADOPTION AGENDA – CONSENT

100 <u>HCR08-89</u> <u>Standardization of Existing Agreements for the Administration of Housing Enhancement Loan Programs in City Redevelopment Areas</u>

Recommendations:

1) Authorize the Interim President and Chief Executive Officer of the Housing Commission to execute the amended standardized Agreements and Scopes of Services with the City Redevelopment Agency to administer the respective Housing Enhancement Loan Programs for the existing Redevelopment Areas of City Heights, Crossroads and Linda Vista, and the incorporation of the existing Mount Hope and Southcrest Areas into the expanded Southeastern San Diego Area in SEDC's Area of Influence.
2) Approve an increase of \$1,000,000 for the Housing Commission's Fiscal Year 2009 budget for owner-occupied Housing Rehabilitation loans to incorporate the tax increment housing set-aside funds for the newly expanded Southeastern San Diego Area Program into the approved Fiscal Year 2009 Housing Commission Budget.

101 <u>HCR08-92</u> <u>Award of Contract for Trash and Recycling Collection Services (Citywide)</u>

Recommendation:

Recommend that the Housing Commission approve the award of a contract to USA Waste of California dba Waste Management of San Diego in the amount of \$248,926 for trash and recycling collection services at Housing Commission owned and/or managed sites for the period of one (1) year with three (3) additional one (1) year options at a negotiated rate not to exceed the base contract amount plus the increase in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U).

102 <u>HCR08-93</u> <u>Award of Contract for Landscape Maintenance Services (Citywide)</u>

Recommendations:

1) Recommend that the Housing Commission approve the award of a contract to Aztec Landscaping, Inc. in the amount of \$164,225 for landscape maintenance services at Housing Commission owned and/or managed sites for the period of one (1) year with two (2) additional one (1) year options at a negotiated rate not to exceed the base contract amount plus the increase in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U).

Authorize the Interim President and Chief Executive Officer to execute the contract (Attachment 1) and expend up to a ten percent contingency (\$16,423), if necessary, for items not anticipated in the original scope of work.

103 HCR08-87 Transitional Housing Grant to San Diego Save Harbor

Recommendations:

That the Housing Commission:

- 1. Approve a \$25,000 Transitional Housing grant to Safe Harbor for their six-bed Safe House program located at 2504 "A" Street, including two one-year renewal options for FY2010 and FY2011 in the amount of \$25,000 each, contingent upon future funding availability and program compliance by Safe Harbor.
- 2. Authorize the Interim President & Chief Executive Officer to execute contracts in a form acceptable to General Counsel.

104 <u>HCR08-88</u> <u>Smart Corner Leasing Arrangements with DAVICH, USA, a California Corporation</u>

Recommendations:

That the Interim President and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) be authorized to execute lease documents between the Housing Commission and DAVICH, USA, for retail space at the Smart Corner building located at 1122 Broadway, on terms set forth in this report and Attachment 1 and in a lease form as approved by General Counsel to the Commission. The lease would have a ten (10) year initial term and one (1) five (5) year option to renew.

105 <u>HCR08-53</u> <u>Loan for Boulevard Apartments (Council District 3)</u>

Recommendation:

Seek Housing Authority approval to fund a Housing Commission loan, of up to \$600,000 to 3137 El Cajon Boulevard L.P., to facilitate development of the Boulevard Apartments (Boulevard), 24 units of rental housing for extremely low-income and very low-income families including units for residents who are homeless or at-risk of becoming homeless, and in which there is a disabled adult with mental illness, HIV/AIDS or substance abuse.

106 <u>HCR08-71</u> <u>Loans for Townspeople 34th Street (Council District 3)</u>

Recommendations:

Recommend to the Housing Authority a permanent loan of up to \$2,040,000, and a predevelopment loan of up to \$40,000, for the acquisition and rehabilitation of a 34-unit mixed-income housing complex with twelve units reserved as permanent rental housing for very low-income persons living with HIV/AIDS.

107 <u>HCR08-90</u> <u>Rehabilitation Period for Hotel Churchill (Council District 2)</u>

Recommendations:

Approve an extension of the end of the rehabilitation period from January 31, 2009, to November 30, 2009, and authorize the Interim Chief Executive Officer and President of the Housing Commission to execute such documents as may be necessary.

108 <u>HCR08-101</u> <u>Memorandum of Understanding with the San Diego Capital Collaborative</u>

Recommendation:

Authorize the Interim President and CEO of the Housing Commission to execute all pertinent documents to effectuate the execution of the MOU.

109 HCR08-95 Employment Contract for Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer of the San Diego Housing Commission and Establishing Compensation for Same

Recommendations:

- 1. That the Chair of the San Diego Housing Commission be authorized to execute an employment agreement with Carrol Vaughan as Executive Director and Chief Operating Officer of the Commission;
- 2. Authorizing the San Diego Housing Commission to take all actions necessary to implement the agreement;
- 3. Requesting that the San Diego Housing Commission approve a budget amendment to FY 09 Budget to authorize the funding of the contract; and,
- 4. Establishing a bonus for Carrol Vaughan for her exemplary service as the Interim President and Chief Executive Officer of the San Diego Housing Commission for the period from January 15, 2008 through October 1, 2008 when the new President and Chief Executive Officer will assume that office.

110 <u>HCR08-97</u> <u>Award of Contract for the Housing Quality Standards (HQS) and Rent Reasonableness Inspection Services</u>

Recommendations:

- 1. That the Housing Commission approve the award of contract to Sterling Companies, Inc. in the amount of \$135,000 for the provision of Housing Quality Standard inspections and Rent Reasonableness determinations, for the period of one year with one additional one-year option.
- 2. Authorize the Interim President & Chief Executive Officer to execute the contract (Attachment 1).
