## SDHC's Hotel Churchill Renovation Honored

SDHC's renovation of the historic Hotel Churchill was recognized with an Orchid award from the San Diego Architectural Foundation for historic preservation.



Orchid Award – Hotel Churchill October 27, 2017

This is the sixth time the Hotel Churchill renovation has been honored.

SDHC, working with its nonprofit affiliate, Housing Development Partners, renovated the Hotel Churchill, originally built in 1914, to create 72 permanent supportive housing rental studios for homeless San Diegans, predominately Veterans.

The renovation of Hotel Churchill was a key component of **HOUSING FIRST – SAN DIEGO**, SDHC's homelessness action plan.
