SDHC Semi-Annual Grants Informational Report

Introduction

- Housing Authority of the City of San Diego Resolution HA-1569:
 - Authorizes the San Diego Housing Commission (SDHC) to apply for and accept awards of grant funding, as well as other grant-related activities
 - Requires SDHC to submit to the Housing Authority a semi-annual report of all grant activity
- This report includes grant activity from July 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018.



SDHC Semi-Annual Grants Informational Report Applications

14 Applications Submitted – more than \$6.2 million

- Federal
 - U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Continuum of Care (\$5.2 million)
 - HUD Family Self-Sufficiency (\$432,000)
 - HUD County of San Diego Community Development Block Grant (\$61,985)
- Private Funds
 - Local Initiatives Support Corporation (LISC) and Citi Foundation (\$190,000 per year for 3 years)
 - Citi Community Development Fund (\$45,000)
 - Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection (\$1,910)
 - State Farm Foundation (\$20,000)





SDHC Semi-Annual Grants Informational Report Awards

6 Grants Awarded - more than \$1.6 million
