A workshop will be presented on the City of San Diego's Community Action Plan on Homelessness.

Through a contract with the San Diego Housing Commission (Housing Commission) on behalf of the City of San Diego, the Corporation for Supportive Housing (CSH), a nationally recognized consultant with broad expertise in the area of homelessness, developed this Community Action Plan.

The initial development of this plan included the creation of a Steering Committee that consisted of key staff members from the office of Mayor Kevin L. Faulconer, the office of San Diego City Councilmember Chris Ward, the Regional Task Force on the Homeless, and the Housing Commission. The Steering Committee supported the work of CSH through all phases of the plan development. The participation and input of more than 200 members of the community, including individuals who have experienced homelessness and those who regularly work directly with individuals experiencing homelessness, contributed to the development of the goals, principles, recommendations and strategies in the Community Action Plan.
