SUBJECT: Workshop & Discussion: Fiscal Year 2021 Moving to Work Annual Plan

NO ACTION IS REQUIRED ON THE PART OF THE HOUSING COMMISSION

An informational workshop will be held on the Fiscal Year 2021 Moving to Work (MTW) Annual Plan. No action is required.

The San Diego Housing Commission (Housing Commission) is one of only 39 housing authorities nationwide (out of 3,400) to receive an MTW designation from U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development HUD. As a result, the Housing Commission has the ability to seek HUD approval to implement a variety of innovative new approaches to provide affordable housing assistance and other services to low-income families within the City of San Diego. Housing Commission staff is developing the Fiscal Year 2021 MTW Annual Plan (Plan), which includes two proposed initiatives, to HUD. The two initiatives, a proposal to establish of alternative reasonable cost limits, and a proposal for the preservation of affordable housing, meet the MTW program objective of increasing housing opportunities for low-income families. The Plan includes a description of both proposed initiatives and how performance will be measured and tracked. In addition to providing information on the draft Plan, the workshop will provide a summary of the impact of MTW on the agency, an update of successes achieved through MTW flexibility, and long-term MTW goals.
