



City of San Diego Affordable Housing Fund Purpose of Annual Plan

- The San Diego Municipal Code requires submission of an Affordable Housing Fund (AHF) Annual Plan to the City Council for action.
- The City of San Diego AHF Annual Plan:
 - Provides a framework for planning and budgeting of fund revenues; and
 - Specifies the amount of funds budgeted for housing activities and administrative expenses.

SDHC's model programs with funding allocations:

Rental Housing Finance:

- New construction of affordable rental housing
- Companion Unit loans
- Preservation of existing affordable housing

Homeownership:

Deferred payment loans and closing cost assistance


Homelessness activities:

- Prevention and diversion
- Landlord engagement and assistance
- Transitional housing and rapid rehousing
- Supportive services






City of San Diego Affordable Housing Fund Revenue Trends


