**SUBJECT:** Workshop & Discussion: Fiscal Year 2022 Moving to Work Annual Plan

### **NO ACTION IS REQUIRED ON THE PART OF THE HOUSING COMMISSION**

An informational workshop will be presented on the Fiscal Year 2022 Moving to Work (MTW) Annual Plan.

The San Diego Housing Commission (Housing Commission) is one of only 39 public housing authorities nationwide (out of 3,400) to receive an MTW designation from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). MTW status provides the Housing Commission the ability to seek HUD approval to implement a variety of innovative new approaches to provide affordable housing assistance and other services to families with low income in the City of San Diego. Housing Commission staff are developing the Fiscal Year 2022 MTW Annual Plan (Plan), which includes two new initiatives. The initiatives include a proposal to provide flexible funding for supportive services and a proposal to allow the Housing Commission to expend MTW funds toward the Housing Commission's existing homeownership programs, as needed. The MTW Annual Plan includes a description of the proposed initiatives and how performance will be measured and tracked. In addition to providing information on the draft MTW Annual Plan, the workshop will provide a summary of the impact of MTW on the Housing Commission, an update of successes achieved through MTW flexibility, and long-term MTW goals.
